

The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 Report for 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020

Trade Union Facility Time Reporting

The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 came into force on the 1st April 2017, which put in place provisions in the Trade Union Act 2016 requiring relevant public sector employers to publish specified information related to facility time provided to trade union officials.

In line with the regulations, the Education Partnership Trust is required to publish the following information relating to trade union officials and facility time:

Trade union representatives and full-time equivalents:

Trade union representatives: 5

FTE trade union representatives: 4.44

Percentage of working hours spent on facility time:

1 to 50% of working hours: 4 representatives51 to 99% of working hours: 0 representatives
