



The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 Report for 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018

Trade Union Facility Time Reporting

The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 came into force on the 1st April 2017. These regulations place a legislative requirement on public sector employers to collate and publish, on an annual basis, a range of data on the amount and cost of facility time within their organisation.

In line with the regulations, the Education Partnership Trust is required to publish the following information relating to trade union officials and facility time:

Relevant Union Officials:

Number of employees who were relevant union officials during the relevant period: 5

Full-time equivalent employee number: 4.88

Percentage of time spent on facility time:

0% of working hours: 0 employees

1 to 50% of working hours: 4 employees

51 to 99% of working hours: 0 employees

100% of working hours: 0 employees

Percentage of pay bill spent on facility time:

Total cost of facility time: £3,038

Total pay bill: £8,810,934

Percentage of the total pay bill spent on facility time: 0%

Paid trade union activities:

Time spent on paid trade union activities as a percentage of total paid facility time hours: 50%
